# NOTICE OF RACE



### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The event will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing Windsurfing Edition and the Class Rules of the participating classes.
- 1.2 National prescriptions will apply.
- 1.3 If there is conflict between the Notice of Raceand the Sailing Instructions(SI's), the SI's will take precedence.
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

### 2 ADVERTISING

Boards may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by theorganizing authority. World Sailing Regulation 20 'Advertising Code' applies.

### 3 CLASSES AND DIVISIONS

- 3.1 The participating **classes** and divisions shall be:
- 3.1.1 **RS:One** Men, Espoir Men, Women, Espoir Women, Master, GrandMaster
- 3.1.2 **RS:X** Men, Women & Youth
- 3.1.3 **Techno 293** Youth Boy and Girl; Junior Boy and Girl
- 3.1.4 **Techno 293 Plus** Youth Boy and Girl; Open Men and Women
- 3.1.5 Formula Windsurfing Open & Masters
- 3.1.6 **Raceboard** Open, Grand Master
- 3.1.7 Foiling Abeam (reaching leg course ) Open
- 3.1.8 Foiling Standard (standard course with upwind leg) Open
- 3.2 **Age Divisions**:
- 3.2.1 An RS:X Youth shall be under 19 years of age and born 2002or later.
- 3.2.2 A Techno Junior shall be under 15 years of age and born 2006 or later
- 3.2.3 A Techno Youth shall be under 17 years of age and born 2004 or later
- 3.2.4 A Techno 293 Plus Youth shall be under 19 years of age, born 2002 or later
- 3.2.5 An RS:One Espoir shall be under 22 years of age, born 1999 or later.
- 3.2.6 A Master shall be 40 years of age or older (born 1979 or earlier).
- 3.2.7 A Grand Master shall be 50 years of age or older(born 1969 or earlier)
- 3.2.8 A minimum of 3 competitors is required to form a class.
  - a) Within a class, a minimum of 3 competitors is required to form a division
  - b) If there are insufficient competitors to form a division, all competitors will compete under a combined division within the class.
  - c) The organizing committee reserves the overall right to decide the final formation of divisions and classes for this event.

### 4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 All entries shall meet the requirements of World Sailing Regulation 19-EligibilityCode.
- 4.2 Competitors shall be members of a National Class Association which is a current paid up member of the relevant international class association. Membership formalities can be completed on site.

### 5 FEES

5.1 The required entry fee for competitors is: S\$ 90 for Raceboard, Foiling & Formula; &

S\$200 for RS:X & RS:One, Techno 293 and Techno 293 Plus.

### 6 RACEFORMAT

- 6.1 Each event in the Singapore Open shall be a *course racing* & "Open entry" event.
- 6.2 Men and women, boys and girls, may race together.
- 6.3 Classes may have separate starts.
- 6.4 Classes shall race a maximum 4 races per day; in a maximum 8 race series for Formula, Foiling and Raceboard; and 12 race series for RS:One, RS:X, Techno 293 and Techno Plus.

### 8 PROTEST COMMITTEE

An 'Independent Protest Committee' will be appointed according to WR91(a).

### 9 SCORING

- 9.1 Scoring will be according to the WCR Appendix A, except as amended below for discards.
- 9.2 When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a board's series score shall be the total of her race scores.
- 9.3 When 4 to 7 races have been completed, a board's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 9.4 When 8 races have been completed, a board's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

### 10 SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall be registered at the race office. Limited charter may be available and may be applied for using the coach entry form.

### 11 SAFETY

Every competitor and support boat crewmember shall wear a personal flotation device that shall conform to the minimum standard of ISO 12402-5 (level 50), or as specified in the SI's.

### 12 PRIZES

- 15.1 Prizes will be awarded to the top three competitors of each properly constituted class /division.
- 15.2 Apart from the Open Division, winners of each division shall only be entitled to prizes within their respective division.

### 13 OFFICIAL CEREMONIES

Competitors are requested to attend the event's social functions; however, the organising authority may refuse entry to those whose standard of attire is not commensurate with the occasion.

# 14 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the event entirely at their own risk, see WCR 4 Decision to Race. The organising authority or any of their officials or representatives or the sponsors or their officials or representatives will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the event.
