#### 8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions (SI's) will be available upon registration. Any changes to the SI's shall be approved by the Organizing Committee.

#### 9. COURSES

Courses will be as described in the sailing instructions.

#### **10. PROTEST COMMITTEE**

An 'Independent Protest Committee' will be appointed.

#### 11. SCORING

11.1.	Scoring will be according to the WCR Appendix A, except as amended below for discards.
11.2.	When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a board's series score shall be the
	total of her race scores.
11.3.	When 4 to 7 races have been completed, a board's series score shall be the total of her
	race scores excluding her worst score.
11.4.	When 8 to 14 races have been completed, a board's series score shall be the total of
	her race scores excluding her two worst scores.
11.5.	When 15 or more races have been completed, a board's series score shall be the
	total of her race scores excluding her three worst scores.

11.6. Marathon race does not form part of the series.

#### 12. SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall be registered at the race office.

#### 13. SAFETY

Every competitor and support boat crew member shall wear a personal flotation device that shall conform to the minimum standard of ISO 12402-5 (level 50), or as specified in the SI's

14.	PRIZES
14.1	Prizes will be awarded to the top three competitors of each properly constituted class /division.
14.2	Apart from the Open Division, winners of each division shall only be entitled to prizes within their respective division.
14.3	Prizes shall also be awarded to Marathon race winners

#### 15. OFFICIAL CEREMONIES

Competitors are requested to attend the event's social functions; however, the organising authority may refuse entry to those whose standard of attire is not commensurate with the occasion.

#### 16. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the event entirely at their own risk, see WCR 4 -Decision to Race. The organising authorities (WAS, Aloha, Constant Wind, SingaporeSailing) or any of their officials or representatives or the sponsors or their officials or representatives will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the event.

#### 17. INSURANCE

Each participant is advised on their own, to take up an insurance to cover any mishaps.

#### 18. RIGHT TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS
