1. RULES

- 1.1. The event will be governed by the rules as defined in 2025 2028 RACING RULES OF SAILING (Windsurfing Fleet Racing Edition) and The Class Rules of participating classes such as:
 - 1.1.1 The T293 & TPlus Class Rules
 - 1.1.2 The International Windsurfer (LT) Class Rule
 - 1.1.3 International IQ Foil Class Rules and related Wind Foil Rules
 - 1.1.4 International Wing Foil Class Rules
- 1.2. No National Authority prescriptions will apply.
- 1.3. If there is conflict between the Class Rules and the Notice of Race, the Notice of Race will take precedence.
- 1.4. If there is conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions (SI's), the SI will take precedence.
- 1.5. If there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence.

2. ADVERTISING

[NP] Boards and sails may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3. CLASSES AND DIVISIONS

3.1. The participating classes and divisions shall be:

From 12/2/2026 to 15/2/2026:

- Techno 293 (T293) Junior Boy & Girl; Youth Boy & Girl
- Techno 293 Plus (TPlus) Open
- IQ Foil U 17 U17 Boy & Girl
- IQ Foil U 19 U19 Boy & Girl
- IQ Foil Open Men & Women

From 14/2/2026 to 15/2/2026:

- Wing Foil Men, Women, Masters, Grand Masters
- Windsurfer LT Grand Master, Master, Man, Women
- 3.2. The Age Divisions shall be:
 - A T293 Junior shall be under 15 years of age (born in or after 2012 but not later than 2014)
 - A T293 Youth, IQ Foil U17 shall be under 17 years of age (born in or after 2010)
 - IQ Foil U19 competitor shall be under 19 years of age (born in or after 2008).
 - A **Master** shall be between 40 -59 years of age in the year of competition (born between 1986 and 1967).
 - A Grand Master shall be 60 years of age or older, in the year of competition (born 1966 or earlier)
 - A minimum of 3 competitors is required to form a class.
 - a) Within a class, a minimum of 3 competitors is required to form a division
 - b) If there are insufficient competitors to form a division, all competitors will compete under a combined division within the class.
 - c) The organizing committee reserves the overall right to decide the final formation of divisions and classes for this event.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1. [NP] Competitors shall be members of a National Class Association which is a current paidup member of the relevant international class association. Membership formalities can be completed on site.
- 4.2. Eligible competitors may register for the event by time 23:59, date 11th January 2026 (Sunday), to enjoy early bird registration discounts.

The following shall be presented upon registration:

- o Original Entry Form
- o Proof of age
- Parental Permission Form- for competitors under the age of 18

5. FEES

- 5.1. The required entry fee for the following classes (4 days racing) are:
 - S\$180 for T293 Junior, IQ Foil U 17 and U19
 - S\$230 for T Plus & IQ Foil

For early bird registration (see 2.2), the entry fees are as follows:

- S\$120 for T293 Junior, IQ Foil U 17 and U19
- S\$180 for T Plus & IQ Foil
- 5.2. The required entry fee for following classes (2 days racing) are as follows:
 - S\$130 for Wing Foil, Windsurfer LT

For early bird registration (see 4.2) the entry fees are as follows:

- For non-full time students: \$\$80 for Wing Foil, Windsurfer LT
- For **full time students**: \$\$50 Wing Foil & Windsurfer LT
- 5.3. Note that the above entry fees applies only to racing fees and does not cover the rental of equipment.
- 5.4. Entry fees may be paid in cash at registration or via bank transfer (see details below) with all bank charges to be borne by the participant.

- 6.2. Men and women, boys and girls, may race together.
- 6.3. [NP] Classes may have separate starts.
- 6.4. [NP] The maximum number of races per day and the maximum number of races per series for each class shall be as follows:

8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions (SI's) will be available upon registration. Any changes to the SI's shall be approved by the Organizing Committee and Class Representative

9. COURSES

Courses will be as described in the sailing instructions.

10. PROTEST COMMITTEE

An 'Independent Protest Committee' will be appointed.

11. SCORING

- 11.1. Scoring will be according to the WCR Appendix A, except as amended below for discards.
 - When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a board's series score shall be the total of her race scores.
 - When 4 to 7 races have been completed, a board's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
 - When 8 to 14 races have been completed, a board's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.
 - When 15 or more races have been completed, a board's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her three worst scores.

12. SUPPORT / COACH BOATS

- 12.1. Support /coach boats shall be registered at the race office.
- 12.2. It is MANDATORY that coach boats stay at least 50m behind the start line

13. SAFETY

- 13.1 Every competitors and support boat crew member shall wear a personal flotation device that shall conform to the minimum standard of ISO 12402-5 (level 50), or as specified in the class rules.
- 13.2 All Foilers shall wear a helmet when racing at sea

14. PRIZES

- 14.1 Prizes will be awarded to the top three competitors of each properly constituted class /division.
- 14.2 Apart from the Open Division, winners of each division shall only be entitled to prizes within their respective division.

15. OFFICIAL CEREMONIES

Competitors are requested to attend the event's social functions; however, the organising authority may refuse entry to those whose standard of attire is not commensurate with the occasion.

16. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the event entirely at their own risk, see WCR 4 -Decision to Race. The organising authorities & supporting parties (WAS, Aloha, Constant Wind, SingaporeSailing) or any of their officials or representatives or the sponsors or their officials or representatives will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the event.

17. INSURANCE

Each participating board shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.

18. RIGHT TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS
